OUR CONCEPT - We partner with like-minded organisations that are already taking care of vulnerable kids in one way or another. These organisations have already invested in various programs to support vulnerable kids and want to see them prosper in life. We want the same things and that's why it's our pleasure to work with other organisations, instead of targeting parents directly for student recruitment. By collaborating with organisations that sponsor our students, we ensure that they are supported throughout their high school experience.

OUR GOALS - In cooperation with our partners, we aim to achieve the following goals:

1. Provide vulnerable kids a fair shot at gaining access to a middle-class life in Kenya and Tanzania.
2. Provide vulnerable kids an elite education, inspiring them to be ethical leaders.
3. Graduate leaders, willing to raise society's living standards by giving back their time and resources.
4. Accelerate orphan reduction efforts by graduating alumni that will propagate orphan supporting values.

PARTNERSHIP BEGINNINGS - As much as there is no one way to start a partnership, we normally have present (face to face) or virtual meetings to get to know each other and to discuss how the partnership can work. We like to focus the conversation on the organisation's inspirations and story, the scale of programs, the current operations, and plans for the future. PARENT/GUARDIAN/PARTNER RESPONSIBILITIES - The parent/guardian, together with the sponsoring organisation, needs to pay for transport to the school ground, take care of buying uniforms and necessary school supplies, and finally make sure students have personal washroom and dormitory items. Please ask us for our "shopping list" containing all the items we consider important for each student to have and that should be provided for.



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Furthermore, we expect the parent/guardian, together with the sponsoring organisation as necessary/practical, to participate in parent/teacher/student phone calls to discuss the students' progress, as well as general strengths and weaknesses.

PWA RESPONSIBILITIES - We ensure regular reports to our partners.

1. Monthly updates on the kids' academic progress and extracurricular participation.
2. Once-a-term online conference with the kids' teaching team.
3. End-of-term reports and regular updates on social media.
4. Availability via phone or email for any question or comment.

PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS - Our goals will be achieved by implementation of a comprehensive program and services to students for their overall wellbeing.

1. Teaching of the Kenyan 8-4-4 curriculum, enhanced by lesson plans.
2. Various extracurricular activities and vocational training courses to open up different doors to different post-high school paths.
3. Activities promoting community and christian values, team spirit, critical thinking, and personal growth.
4. Mentorships programs.
5. Full board and 24/7 nurturing care and supervision. Our students have the possibility to live in the dormitories of our school where they will be supervised and cared for throughout the day by our staff.

This is why we wish through our education program to contribute to the work the organisations have been doing so far in guaranteeing a better future for vulnerable kids.
